
Your child's needs as a learner are at the heart of our approach to education. Our Cambridge Pathway aims to give your child a love of learning that will stay with them through school, university and beyond.

What is Cambridge ICT Starters?

Schools will typically offer Cambridge ICT Starters at the Cambridge Primary or Cambridge Lower Secondary stage. It is available in English and Spanish.

Information and Communications Technology (ICT) is now part of the educational experience of learners in most parts of the world. It is regarded as a new 'literacy', alongside reading, writing and numeracy.

Cambridge ICT Starters is made up of modules appropriate for different ages and levels of skill. This means programmes can be delivered according to the needs of each learning situation and age of the students.

Cambridge ICT Starters builds knowledge and skills in:

- use computer devices safely and ethically
- information gathering and analysis.
- effective use of ICT for a variety of purposes
- the use of ICT and the effectiveness of ICT in the wider world.

Cambridge ICT Starters has been mapped against ICT standards in a number of countries, so that the skills and knowledge assessed reflect the competencies demanded internationally. Learners will receive a certificate when they successfully complete each stage of Cambridge ICT Starters.
